



# NEW GLOBAL CITIZENS TEAM CONSTITUTION

The name of this campus club will be a New Global Citizens (NGC) Team. No other chapter shall exist as long the NGC Team is still intact and functioning.

**Purpose:** New Global Citizens seeks to educate, equip and mobilize young people to help solve the greatest challenges faced by communities around the world, through New Global Citizens Teams on high school campuses.

Each school year NGC Teams will create and implement action plans to support Global Projects in communities around the world, through three main objectives: community education, advocacy and fundraising.

**Membership:** Membership is open to all students and faculty of \_\_\_\_\_ High School.

**Team:** An NGC Team will consist of:

- ✓ At least 3 student Team Leaders;
- ✓ At least 1 campus Advisor;
- ✓ Additional students and school faculty, as the Team Members determine.

**Sponsors:** Each NGC Team must have at least one onsite Advisor (typically a teacher or guidance counselor), who will serve as the lead sponsor. Teams may consist of additional Advisors if they choose.

**Organization:** The following positions will make up the leadership of the NGC team, at minimum. Additional positions are at the discretion of the Team Leaders and Members.

List Leadership Positions & Descriptions Here:

**Meetings:** Team Members will meet weekly on campus, with meeting place & time determined by the team and Advisor, with dates and times publicized in advance.

**Elections:** Elections will be held in the spring to determine leadership officers for the following school year. A quorum (simple majority) of official members must be in attendance at the election meeting. Nominations will be open to all official members of NGC. A candidate receiving the majority of the votes cast will be elected to the office.

In case of a resignation, the Team Leaders may, with onsite Advisor's approval, call for a special election.

**Amendments:** This constitution will be considered ratified when approved by 2/3 of the voting members.

This constitution may be amended or changed when approved by 2/3 of the voting members.
